

Reading

All children are to read at least three times per week at home and for an adult to sign their reading record. There is an example of

how to write a quality comment in your child's record. On a weekly basis, children will earn raffle tickets for how many times they read, giving them the chance to win prizes at the end of every half term.





PE

PE lessons are on Thursdays. Children will need to have the appropriate kit for these lessons: white t-shirt and black shorts or jogging bottoms. During the autumn term, PE lessons will be indoors to cover Gym and Dance units of PE curriculum so trainers are not necessary. PE kit can be left in the Jigsaw room for the whole half term if this helps your morning rush!

Outdoor Learning

Our topic will include outdoor practical learning in our school garden area and so it would be really useful if children could bring in an old pair of jeans or joggers to wear – that you don't mind getting dirty! – as well as a pair of wellies or old trainers. Again, we will happily keep these in school if this simplifies things. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name.





Homework

Homework will be handed out every Monday.

This will be expected to be completed and handed in by the Friday of every week.

Homework will usually consist of one piece of maths work and one piece of literacy work.

At times, homework linked to our topic theme may be given instead. Details will be given with the homework on timescale for completion.



How can you support your child?

- Work with school – we are all in this to provide the best for your child, we need to work together and show demonstrate a good relationship to the children
- 95+% attendance and good punctuality will mean they access the provision for their learning needs
- Make sure they get a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast – their day at school is busy, hard work and challenging. Give them the best start.
- Read with them at least 3 times a week and write a comment in their reading record.
- Make sure they complete homework – this does not have to be done in one session, break it up into small chunks, maybe 5 or 10 minutes each night
- Make sure they are prepared for their day at school – glasses every day if they wear them, reading book, reading record and contact book in school every day, PE kit in on the day needed and any permission slips returned on time
- If you have any concerns, please come and speak with us. If we are not available straight away, we can arrange a time
