Woodlands Walking Bus

What is it?

The Walking Bus is a scheme operated by Woodlands School and supported by Telford and Wrekin Council. The Walking Bus provides qualified staff to guide and supervise children travelling to school and follows a set published route according to an established timetable. Children can join the bus at prearranged pickup stops

What are the benefits?

The Walking Bus provides many benefits to children, their parents/ guardians and the school.

For example:

Children arrive at school alert and ready for the day ahead

Walking is a healthy form of exercise

Improves road safety skills and encourages safe pedestrian behaviour

A walking bus may help alleviate traffic congestion around the school

Helps save time for busy parents who have younger children at home

Helps address lateness/school timekeeping
