Well done to this week's fabulous SOS winners!

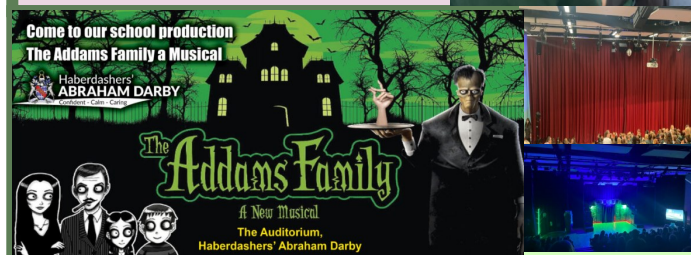


Well done to all the children who attend our after school martial arts club. Everyone has now completed their first grading, showcasing their new skills, passing the various stages and being presented with their yellow belt!
