Department for Education's new attendance and punctuality regulations

We are writing to inform you of important changes in attendance regulations which are effective from the start of this academic year. Two very important changes include regulations around issuing penalty notices for regular unauthorised absences and punctuality to school. These changes are national and apply to all schools, including Woodlands. It is crucial that you are fully aware of these new policies as they directly impact our children and families.

More information can be found on our website and we are offering parent workshops on Tuesday 26th September and 3rd October in school at 9am.

Unauthorised Absences and Penalty Notices

A penalty notice can be issued once a child has 10 sessions of unauthorised absence within a window of 10 school weeks (a school day contains two sessions, morning and afternoon). This can be any combination of unauthorised absences and can cover different terms or even school years.

Penalty Notice and Legal Intervention

First penalty notices are charged at £160 per parent, per child. This amount is reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days. Second penalty notices are £180 per parent, per child. A third penalty notice cannot be issued to the same parent in respect of the same child within 3 years of the date of the first and therefore alternative action may be taken instead, including legal intervention.

Punctuality and Impact

Our school gates open at 8.40am and children should arrive by 8.50am. If they arrive after this time, they are marked as late. If a child arrives after 9.20am, the register will be marked as an unauthorised absence for the morning session. Therefore, if you bring your child in after 9.20am on a regular basis, this will lead to a penalty notice being issued by the Local Authority, which we do not want for our families. We realise this would very quickly happen for families who regularly bring their children in late.

Finally we understand that these changes may cause concern, but these are national changes from the Department for Education and not by Woodlands or Telford and Wrekin Council. We will continue to work with you to support your child's attendance and punctuality and if you would like any support, please contact me, Mrs Fisher or Mrs Craven.
