Addition and Subtraction: Mental, written and concrete strategies to solve addition and subtraction calculations to 50.

Place value: Count forwards and backwards within 100, recognise tens and units, compare and order numbers to 50, read numbers to 100.

Statistics: Pictograms and tallies.

Multiplication and division: Count in 2, 3, 5 and 10s, multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables, write calculations using the x and ÷ symbol, use arrays to solve calculations.
